- This Ramzan, Aftar arrangements were done at Punjab University on which much appreciation was received.

- An invitation was sent to Mr. Shawaz Baluch for the designation of Project Director, by the DWAF.
- Audit was made in August, 2018.
- Exemption letter was renewed by FBR.
- Registration for SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT is renewed up to 2020.
- Murree tour was arranged for students of DWAF by Punjab Welfare Trust for the Disabled.
- Free tuition services were provided to the needy and poor students.
- Murree tour was again arranged for the students of DWAF by Punjab Welfare Trust for the Disabled. Training sessions were conducted in PEEF for students.
- On the second day of Eid, at the death of office admin, Mr. Shahid Nadeem, all members expressed sorrow.
- Problems were faced regarding salary, as it was not paid on time.
- When PSDF registered us, recommendations were made on receiving more projects. When Miss Farhat met CEO of PSDF, we got a new project.
- PWTD conducted a meeting for Disability Day in which students from Lahore and Okara branch performed National Anthem in sign language.
- Classes for sign language were started in which women took an active part and students of AIOU also joined.
- After discussions, on 3rd December, 2018 students performed National Anthem in sign language at Al Hamra Hall.
- PWTD arranged an event on 18th November, 18 in which free of cost checkups were given to the disable people.
- An event was organized at Race Course Park on 28th and 29th November, 2018 where students performed National Anthem in sign language.
- Like every past year, Rising Sun Institute arranged Disable Day this year also, in which students of DWAF took part in National Anthem and performed it in sign language.
- DWAF opened new place where setup was made to provide education to children. Township branch was inaugurated where admissions has been started.
- Certificates were distributed in January 2019 students

- Deaf super league organized in April 2019
- Rashan distribution for deaf people or students in May from Akhuwat.
- Sign language courses started
- Tour of YDC Murree was organized with collaboration of PWTD
- Signed on Deaf talk with MOU, the launching ceremony invitation were distributed
- Searcher training workshop was organized in July, 2019
