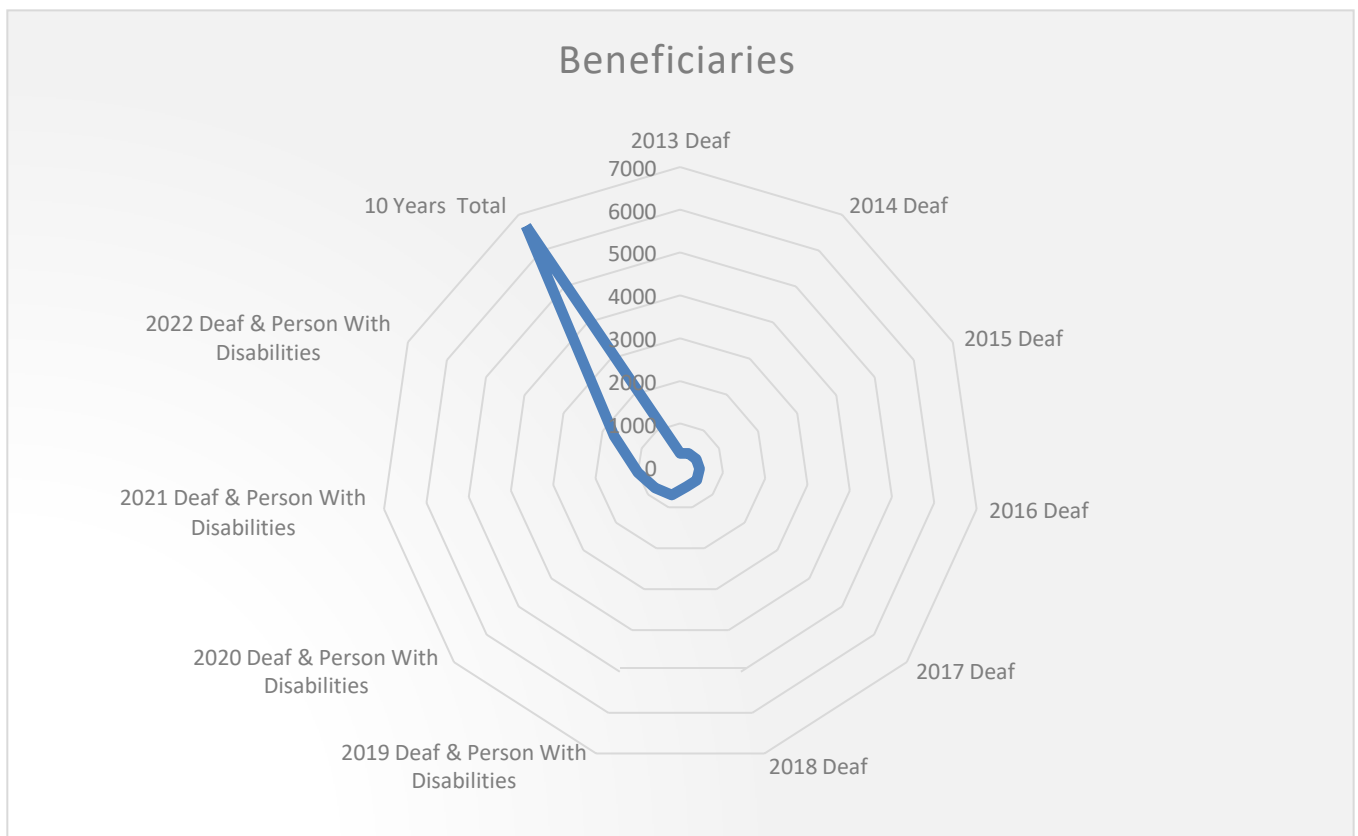

January

DWAF's blanket drive aims to provide for the vulnerable deaf community of Pakistan who are at the risk of cold due to the inaccessibility of blankets in this winter season.

Deaf Welfare Awareness Foundation* visited two villages of DG Khan named Nahalni and Muridni near Mount Sulaiman, helping the flood victims.

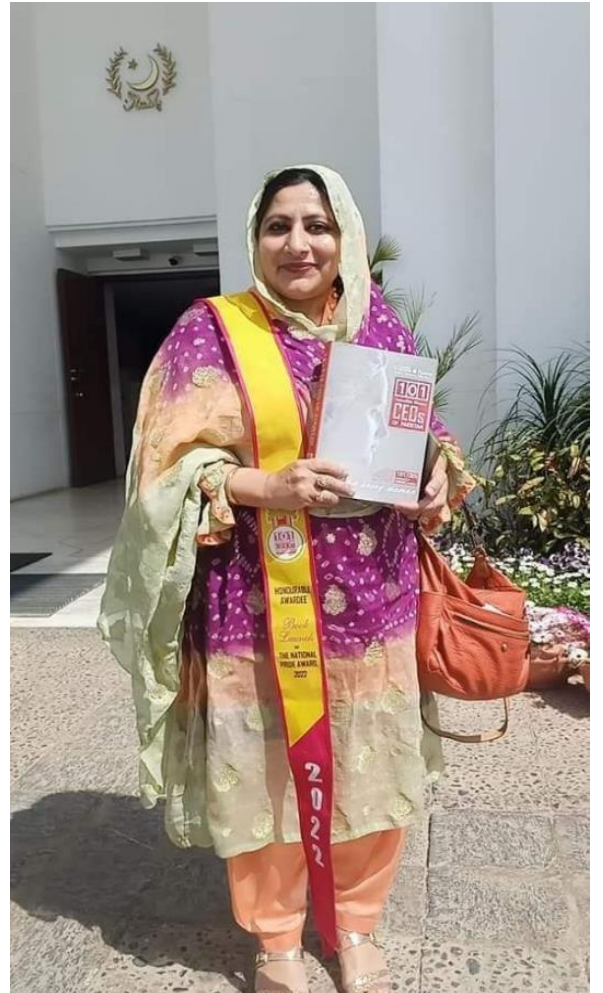
November
